1. 'A' Certificate Tests

Further discussion took place on the planned A test training days. A series of questions and answers will be compiled to assist with members preparation.

2. Weather Station

It has been noted that the weather station has been defective for some time in as much as the wind direction is no longer updated. The gliding club will be asked to fix it. As the station was partly funded by CRCS it may be that the gliding club could ask for a contribution towards maintainance.

As detailed local weather conditions are easily available online these days it was questioned whether there remained a need for the weather station.

3. Flightline Rules

There is an ongoing problem with members failing to observe the club rules when flying. Unfortunately this extends to long standing and experienced members as well as those that are newer to the club. Verbal reminders of incursions often result in negative responses as nobody likes being told off.

To get around this a single sheet leaflet covering the most basic rules will be produced that can then be handed to those who are seen not to be observing the correct procedures. The sign over the flight box by the car parking area will be replaced with one that also notes the basic rules a the allowed flying area in the hope that the message will slowly sink in.

4. Diary Dates

The last club meeting of the winter session will be Thursday 2nd. April.

The first one after the summer will be on Thursday 1st. October.

'A' Certificate training days will be 11th 18th 25th April. These dates have changed slightly to avoid the Easter holiday.

5. First Aid Kit
