1. Resignations and Applications

8. Fees

Gliding Club has increased Associate membership by £5. At the time of writing the BMFA is considering making no increase but we will not know until later in the year. If the BMFA fee does go up, Terry Clarke suggested absorbing that increase for the this year. CRCS will not increase fees this year. The total fee for CRCS membership will be £112.
