1. Minutes

2. Talk by Andy Westgate

5. Debris on the runway

Some debris from model flying had been left on the runway, and this could cause serious problems to the gliders. Club members need to be notified that the runway must be kept clear and that debris must be removed.

6. BMFA Examiner

Mario Malecki confirmed that he was working on getting Club Examiner status.

7. Fly-in

It was confirmed that the fly-in would be held on Sunday 7th October. Chris Bowler had been informed and the Chedworth members invited. It was also hoped that Steve Holland would be able to attend. Mario Malecki would be in charge on the day and the pilot's briefing would be held at 9:45am.

8. Failsafes

It was understood that new regulations were being introduced, making it mandatory for failsafes to be used with all models where the transmitter had a failsafe facility. Doug Garland offered to research the topic and report back to the committee.
