

CRCS Committee meeting notes for July 1st 2021

The meeting was held at Ian Halliday's house on July 1st 2021 and started at 19.30 hours.

Present :- Jon Parker (chair) – Bob Maltby (Vice Chair) Ian Halliday (Treasurer) Gordon Bishop and Doug Garland.

Jon read the notes of the previous meeting (3rd June 2021) and all agreed that they were a true record of the meeting – they were then signed as agreed by the chairman.

Matters arising:-

Gordon reported that he could not get any suitable radios from his contacts as there has been many significant changes to the old system and only newer compatible radios would suffice. Bob Maltby said that he would look into the cost of new equipment and report back at the next committee meeting. Either way we need to provide a radio as the GGC would not fund the cost. The GGC chairman has agreed to check with their solicitor to develop a suitable written disclaimer for CRCS about the use of the radio as we cannot guarantee that it will be manned at all times.

Camping Weekend :-

This was very successful with no mishaps or issues.

The GGC is looking to buy some of the land becoming available at Aston Down. There was a discussion about CRCS buying or renting some of the land to secure our tenure. No decisions were made but Jon will look into this with the GGC chairman. Work in progress

Finance :-

At the moment the interest rates of the bank are very minimal and Ian will look into the possibility of better investment prospects and will make his recommendations when he has gathered the information.

Automatous Flying :-

A club member has flown an automatous flying model at Aston Down. There was much discussion about the pros and cons of automatous flying at Aston Down and the committee reached an unanimous decision that as AD is an active airfield it is not suitable for this type of flying to take place there.

A proposal was put forward that (No model is allowed to be flown at Aston Down without the pilot being in full control at all time). Proposed by Bob Maltby seconded by Gordon Bishop. This was put to the vote and all members present voted for the proposal with none against. The proposal was accepted and passed.

Ian will make these notes available on the website and the club rules will be modified accordingly. The chairman will write to the member flying this model and explain the committee's decision.
